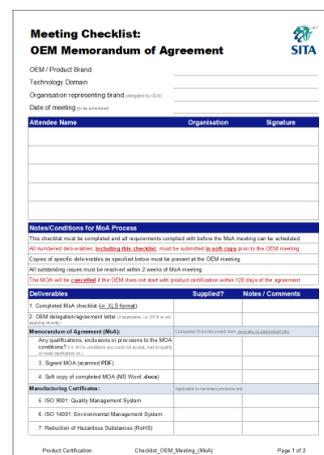
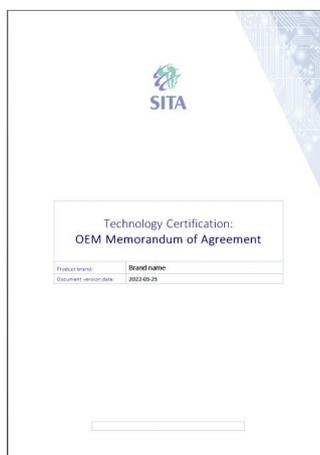
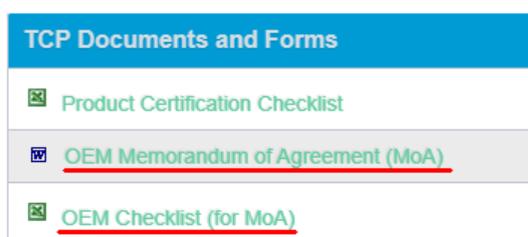




# Documentation: SITA OEM Agreement Process (MoA)

In order for any products to be certified, the brand first needs to get an OEM Agreement in place with SITA. Go to [www.sita.co.za/prodcert.htm](http://www.sita.co.za/prodcert.htm) and download the following 2 documents:

- **OEM Memorandum of Agreement (MoA)** – agreement between the brand and SITA
- **OEM Checklist:** Excel file listing MoA process requirements and deliverables



Complete the MoA in full, indicating in Section 3 all the organisation’s details as well as the **Technology Domain(s)** (PCD / Peripherals / Assistive / AVCT / Srv&Stor / NET / INFRA / EDU / SAC) into which the products will fit. Sign the completed MoA and scan it to PDF for the 1<sup>st</sup> copy.

Complete the OEM Checklist, and source all the required deliverables. (There are about 10 different deliverables, **including** the completed Checklist and 2 copies of the MoA.)

Once the above is done, submit all the documents via e-mail or cloud file share. Upon receipt of the documentation, SITA will request a meeting to process the MoA paperwork.

Once the MoA is concluded, the process to certify products for supply to Government can start.

**Note:** If SITA does not revert within 2-3 days, please follow up. It could be a comms issue.
